**Nobile Limited Release Sauvignon Blanc 2012 £5.49
from £10.99**

Snap this up if you love New Zealand Sauvignon. What a bargain. Fresh, vibrant with tropical fruit and citrus flavours.



**Château Sénéjac 2008 Cru Bourgeois, Haut-Médoc £11.99
from £16.99**

This ancient estate has a history stretching back four centuries and is currently responsible for some of the best-value wines in the Medoc. The feted team at the illustrious Château Pontet-Canet oversee the winemaking here and the results over the past few vintages have been a revelation. This is a glorious, cedary claret, ever-so-slightly austere with blackcurrant and black cherry fruit, carefully balanced to provide a wine of great poise and structure.



**Château Belgrave 2008 5ième Cru Classé £19.99 from
£24.99**

Rated as a “Fifth Growth” in the famous 1855 classification, Château Belgrave consists of 61 acres of enviably sited gravelly vineyards, separated by only a stream from the Saint-Julien appellation. The wines have improved immeasurably in recent years under the careful stewardship of the excellent winemaking team at Dourthe. A blend of 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 42% Merlot and a smidgeon of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot, this is textbook claret; fine, supple tannins, compelling purity of fruit and a long, dry finish. Laura was

very impressed on a recent visit and enjoyed tasting with the winemaker, 'assisting' in his selection of new coopers and barrels.

The two from Asda worth mentioning are from the Jacob's Creek Reserve Range and are on offer until 3rd January 2013.



Jacob's Creek Reserve Riesling and Reserve Shiraz £6.98 from £9.98
South Australia's Barossa region is recognised for producing exceptional dry Riesling which is one of Australia's classic wine styles as well as ripe Shiraz. The Riesling shows elegance and structure complementing the citrus fruit character and the full-bodied Shiraz, intense blackberry and cherry with lively black pepper notes.
