The prices of the wines are very fair and the pick of the bunch for us are the following:

The mixed cases of Second Wines (£175.50 for 6 bottles) and Classed Growths (£360 for 6 bottles) both look good and a useful way of exploring several estates.



All the prices are for 6 bottles.

La Demoiselle de Sociando £124.50

As those of you who attended the Sociando-Mallet tasting in October will know, this is a simply lovely wine, drinking beautifully now but will keep, too.



Château Brown £150

Richard admits to his (unashamed) favouritism for Château Brown as he works for them, but Laura is also a fan. The white is delicious, too.



Château Labegorce £129

This is an excellent and not too expensive example of Margaux.



Château Les Ormes de Pez £139.50

A château which has been on fire in recent vintages and there is no exception with the 2009.



Château Cantemerle £150

This is great price for a very respectable Grand Cru Classé.



Château Gloria £210

A perennial favourite with the Brits and consistently good in recent vintages.



Château Pichon Longueville Baron £750

You can't go wrong if you are looking for something really special.
